Phil also became internationally known for his work with PE4LIFE, a nonprofit organization that develops children's fitness programs targeting childhood obesity.

On April 23, 2010 he lost his long battle with cancer. Number 29, Phil's number, was retired and presently continues to flutter with pride overlooking Naperville Central's varsity baseball field. He left behind, not only a family who loved and adored him, but an entire community that loved and adored him as well. He will always be Batting 4 A Cure.
